Flower color varies depending on soil pH
Low pH or Acidic soil conditions Blue higher pH Pink blooms

Lace Cap = Flat Flower type
Hortensis = Ball shaped
Panicle = Elongated type

H130	arborescens Grandiflora (Hills of Snow)	White	Stable	3-6'	Hortensis	Branches arc when in bloom, smaller flws. than Annabelle
H152	Blue Wave	Blue	Variable	4-6'	Lace Cap	Seedling of Maresii, wavy edged florets
H154	Cardinal	Red	Stable	3-6'	Hortensis	Vigorous growing, color intensity depends on soil pH
H140	Coerulea Lace	Blue	Stable	4-6'	Lace Cap	Single, one of the hardiest
H150	Compacta	Blue	Variable	3-5'	Hortensis	Double, More compact than Nikko, dark green leaves
H155	Domotoi	Pale Pink	Variable	4'	Hortensis	Pale pink blue, large flowers
H157	Endless Summer	Blue	Variable	4' x 4'	Hortensis	Blooms on new and old wood.
H158	Glowing Embers	Red	Stable	4'	Hortensis	Double, glossy foliage
H169	Limelight	Limegreen	Stable	6'-8'	Panicle	Excellent vigor. Grows well in containers.
H166	macrophylla 'Ayesha'	Blue	Variable	5'	Hortensis	Light scent, mid-green foliage. Free flowering.
H149	macrophylla 'Blue Billow'	Rich blue	Variable	5'	Lace Cap	Very cold hardy.
H151	macrophylla 'Lemon Wave'	Mauve	Variable	6'	Hortensis	Variegated foliage; white, yellow, cream, green.
H156	Mariesii	Pink	Stable	4-6'	Lace Cap	Pale blue in very acid soils
H195	Merritt Supreme	Dark Pink	Stable	4-5'	Hortensis	Compact form, large florets
H196	Merritt's Beauty	Carmine Red	Stable	4-6'	Hortensis	
H160	Nikko Blue	Blue	Variable	4-6'	Hortensis	Vigorous growing, large flower
H170	paniculata Grandiflora (Pee Gee)	White	Stable	15-20'	Panicle	Turn pinkish later, zone 4, also available in tree form.
H174	paniculata Kyushu	Creamy white	Stable	10'	Panicle	Open and elegant growth habit. Also available in tree form.
H173	paniculata 'Pink Diamond'	Creamy pink	Stable	10'	Panicle	Late summer bloom, tall open panicle. Available in tree form.
H175	paniculata Tardiva	White	Stable	10-12'	Panicle	6" flowers. Also available in tree form.
H162	Pink Beauty	Reddish pink	Variable	3-4'	Hortensis	Double, smaller flowers, mahogany leaf color
H178	Pink Elf (Pia)	Pink	Stable	2'	Hortensis	Good for containers or confined areas, zone 6

H179	quercifolia 'Alice'	Creamy white	Stable	10'	Panicle	Vigorous dark green to burgandy foliage.
H180	quercifolia (Oak Leaf)	White	Variable	4-6'	Panicle	stoliniferous, exfoliating bark, good fall color
H184	quercifolia Pee Wee	White	Variable	2-3'	Panicle	Compact growing form
H181	quercifolia Snow Queen	White	Variable	3-6'	Panicle	Upright panicles, more numerous
H182	quercifolia Snowflake	White	Variable	3-6'	Panicle	Double, heavy heads weigh branches down
H183	serrata Blue Bird	Light Blue	Variable	4-6'	Lace Cap	Light pink if high pH, blue center, zone 6
H148	serrata Preziosa	Pink	Stable	3-4'	Hortensis	Narrower leaves, flowers start pink fade to dark red.
H189	Sikes Dwarf	White	Stable	3'x3'	Panicle	Stays a nice compact , dwarf , oakleaf hydrangea.
H164	Sister Theresa	White	Stable	4-5'	Hortensis	Pink blush to flowers
H146	Tellar White	Creamy white	Stable	4x5'	Lace Cap	Large shrub. May give the impression of a mophead when mature.
H165	Tokyo Delight	White	Stable	5'	Lace Cap	Leaves russet to purple in Autum. Fertile flowers pink.
H190	Variegata	Blue	Variable	4'	Lace Cap	Leaves edged creamy white,like Maresii but variegated, zone 6
